- 1. The Hollywood Sign is a landmark icon of Los Angeles, but it was first known as the Hollywoodland Sign.
- 2. Not only did the original letters stand fifty feet tall, but each also lit up at night to draw the eye.
- 3. Most people associate the sign with the film industry in Hollywood, yet the sign was originally intended to advertise a real-estate development.
- 4. Whether viewed as a quaint remnant of classic Los Angeles or a contemporary landmark, the sign has become a "must-see" for tourists visiting the area
- 5. The letters appear straight when viewed from high altitude, but from the ground, the contours of the mountain create an illusion of waviness.
- 6. The original sign fell into disrepair and was the subject of frequent vandalism, so a campaign to restore it was taken up in 1978.
- 7. The total cost of restoration was \$250,000 and was divided equally amongst nine donors who each restored a single letter of the sign.
- 8. Rock musician Alice Cooper wished to commemorate his departed friend, the comedian Groucho Marx, so he commissioned one of the "O's" in his name.
- 9. Other donors included Hugh Hefner, Gene Autry, and Andy Williams.
- 10. The only corporate donor was Warner Bros. Records, but, strangely, they did not restore the "W" in the sign but instead the other "O."
