- 1. Born in West Hartford, Connecticut, Noah Webster created his own dictionary of the English language to rival those of Murray and Johnson.
- 2. Webster held many positions during his lifetime, but he never erred in the mission of educating the nation and its children.
- 3. His blue-backed spellers, which remained a staple in American classrooms for over a century, taught many generations to spell the words of their native language.
- 4. He set out to write an American dictionary that would standardize spelling and usage throughout the growing nation.
- 5. Each of the country's regions used different spellings for common words at the time, which bothered Webster and other serious academics.
- 6. Webster taught himself 28 different languages during the 26 years it took to write his dictionary, and many of the etymologies he wrote reflect this astounding learning.
- 7. Much of his work was original, since 12,000 of the 70,000 words in his dictionary had never appeared in any other lexicon before.
- 8. What did Americans think? Sadly, this monumental effort fell upon an unappreciative nation, who only purchased 2,500 copies of the first edition.
- 9. Webster remained true to his own vision and financed his second edition himself.
- 10. The poet Emily Dickinson was one of his biggest fans, claiming she read every page of her own copy of the work.
