1. The Eiffel Tower is an iron lattice tower located on the Champ de Mars in Paris.
2. The tower is the tallest structure in Paris and the most-visited paid monument in the world.
3. During its construction, the Eiffel Tower surpassed the Washington Monument to assume the title of the tallest man-made structure in the world.
4. It retained this title until the Chrysler Building was erected in 1930.
5. Because of the addition of the antenna atop the Eiffel Tower in 1957, it is now taller than the Chrysler Building by seventeen feet.
6. Not including broadcast antennae, it is the second-tallest structure in France, after the Millau Viaduct.
7. The tower has three levels for visitors, with restaurants on the first and second.
8. The third level observatory's upper platform is 906 feet above the ground, the highest accessible to the public in the European Union.
9. The tower is 1,063 feet tall, about the same height as an 81-storey building.
10. The tower received its 250 millionth visitor in 2010.
