- 1. London's Tower Bridge was built from 1886 to 1894.
- 2. It is a combined bascule and suspension bridge, which crosses the River Thames.
- 3. It is close to the Tower of London, from which it takes its name.
- 4. The bridge consists of two towers with two horizontal walkways.
- 5. It has been designed to withstand the horizontal forces exerted by the sections of the bridge on the landward sides of the towers.
- 6. The vertical component of the forces in the suspended sections and the vertical reactions of the two walkways are carried by the two robust towers.
- 7. The bascule pivots and operating machinery are housed in the base of each tower.
- 8. The bridge's present color scheme dates from 1977, when it was painted red, white and blue for Queen Elizabeth II's silver jubilee.
