- 1. John Winston Lennon was born 9 October 1940 while his father was away at sea.
- 2. Lennon was actually raised by his aunts for most of his childhood, and <u>he lost his</u> <u>mother while he was still a teenager</u>.
- 3. John described himself as a troublemaker <u>that constantly made enemies in school</u> and knew that his friend Paul McCartney's father would have preferred that his son not be friends with him.
- 4. <u>Although he never finished Art School</u>, it was there he met his first wife Cynthia.
- 5. Lennon formed The Quarrymen <u>when he was 15 years old</u>, and this band would later transform itself into the Beatles, the most successful group in the history of popular music.
- 6. Lennon asked McCartney to join the band in 1957, and <u>they would later add</u> <u>McCartney's friend George Harrison</u>.
- 7. At this time, Lennon was finding his voice as a songwriter.
- 8. <u>Although they first performed covers of popular rhythm and blues songs</u>, the Quarrymen eventually began to play their own music.
- Lennon and McCartney formed a partnership <u>that would be responsible for about</u> <u>180 songs</u> that have sold over 250 million records.
- 10. By the time of his death, <u>Lennon was considered one of the great voices of his</u> <u>generation</u>.
